Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Central Government is implementing any aviation training and skill development programmes in the State of Odisha;
- (b) if so, the details of such programmes and the financial assistance provided till date;
- (c) whether any financial assistance or sponsorship is provided to students for pilot, cabin crew, aircraft maintenance, or other aviation-related training; and
- (d) the number of beneficiaries from the State of Odisha under such schemes till date?

a to d) The Ministry is committed towards development of training and skill development in aviation. The following organizations/institutes in Odisha are approved by Directorate General of Civil Aviation for training/skill development in aviation:-

(i) 01 Flying Training Organization namely Government Aviation Training Institute (GATI),

(ii) 05 Authorized Remote Pilot Training Organisations (RPTOs),

(iii) 02 Aircraft Maintenance Engineering (AME) training institutes under CAR 147 Basic.

As of now, there is no such scheme providing any financial assistance or sponsorship to students for pilot, cabin crew, aircraft maintenance, or other aviation-related training.
