National Highways in Haryana

2831. SHRI SANJAY BHATIA:

Will the Minister of Road Transport and Highways be pleased to state:

- (a) increase in the total length of National Highways in the State of Haryana during the last five years, district-wise details thereof;
- (b) whether Government has any proposal to expand the National Highway network in Haryana through four/six-laning of National Highways, Greenfield Corridors, Ring Roads and Bypass projects, if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether Government has prepared any long-term action plan to enhance the overall route density and carrying capacity of National Highways in Haryana in view of the increasing industrial, agricultural and freight traffic in the State, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) Length of National Highway (NH) network in the State of Haryana has increased from 3,237 km to 3,342 km since April, 2021. District-wise details of newly declared/extended/realigned NHs in the State of Haryana is as under:

The development and maintenance of NHs is a continuous process. The development/upgradation of NHs is taken up based on several factors such as current traffic on the stretch, availability of requisite land, alternate routes available, geographical location and synergy with PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan (NMP).

Details of ongoing projects of four/six-laning of NHs, Greenfield Corridors, Ring Roads and Bypass in the State of Haryana are at Annexure-I.

The Government receives proposals from various State Governments / Union Territories (UTs), from time to time, for declaration / upgradation of State Roads, including State Highways (SHs), as new NHs. Decisions are taken to notify State Roads as NHs from time to time based on the broad principles of declaration of NHs, requirement of connectivity, traffic density and synergy with PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan (NMP).
