MISSION SHAKTI IN JAMMU AND KASHMIR

2866 SHRI SAT PAUL SHARMA:

Will the Minister of **WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) total financial allocation and expenditure incurred in Jammu and Kashmir for implementation of the umbrella 'Mission Shakti' scheme since its formal launch;
- (b) the number of emergency cases that have been handled by the One Stop Centres and the Women Helpline (181) under 'Sambal' vertical across the UT, details thereof;
- (c) implementation status of newly introduced 'Nari Adalat' women collectives in Jammu and Kashmir;
- (d) number of local disputes resolved, details thereof; and
- (e) institutional steps being taken under Skill Acquisition and Knowledge Awareness for Livelihood Promotion (SANKALP) hub to establish working women's hostels (Sakhi Niwas) and creche facilities in industrial regions?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT

(a) to (e): The Ministry of Women and Child Development is implementing Centrally Sponsored Schemes in the country for the welfare of women and children, which are placed under three verticals, viz. (1) Mission Shakti, for safety, protection and empowerment of women; (2) Saksham Anganwadi & Poshan 2.0 for improving nutrition & health indicators in the country; and (3) Mission Vatsalya, for protection and welfare of children in difficult circumstances.

The 'Mission Shakti' aims at strengthening interventions for women safety, security and empowerment. Mission Shakti comprises of two verticals 'Sambal' for safety and security of women and 'Samarthya' for empowerment of women.

The 'Sambal' has components of One Stop Centre (OSC), Women Helpline (WHL), Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) and Nari Adalat. The 'Samarthya' has components of Shakti Sadan, Sakhi Niwas, Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY), Palna and SANKALP: Hub for Empowerment of Women (SANKALP: HEW).

One Stop Centre (OSC) provides integrated and immediate support and assistance under one roof to women affected by violence and those in distress, both in private and public spaces all across the country. It provides services like medical aid, legal aid and advice, temporary shelter, police assistance and psycho-social counselling to needy women across the country. As on date, 991 One Stop Centres have been made operational across the country and since inception, i.e. 1st April, 2015 to 30th June, 2026, over 15.20 lakh women have been assisted through One Stop Centres across the country. As on date, 20 OSCs are operational in the UT of Jammu Kashmir, which have assisted over 19,601 women.

Women Helpline (WHL-181) provides 24-hour toll-free telecommunication services to support women in both emergency and non-emergency situations. It offers assistance to women affected by violence and provides information about government schemes and services. Since inception (1st April, 2015 to 30th June, 2026), over 1.04 crore women have been assisted through Women Helplines across the country. In the UT of Jammu Kashmir, WHL has assisted over 51,095 women till 30th June, 2026.

Nari Adalat scheme provides a platform for alternative grievance redressal for women at the gram panchayat level. The Adalats are mandated to help women in distress at the panchayat level in resolving smaller issues relating to domestic violence, and other gender-based violence by negotiation, mediation, and reconciliation with mutual consent for accessible justice.

The scheme is demand driven and piloted in 50 Gram Panchayats each in the State of Assam and the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir in FY 2023-24. In the State of Bihar, Jharkhand, Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Manipur, Mizoram, Nagaland, Punjab, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Tripura and Uttar Pradesh, Nari Adalat is operational in 10 Gram Panchayats in each of the States. In FY 2025-26, 10 Gram Panchayats each in 4 States of Goa, Maharashtra, Odisha, Uttarakhand and 5 Gram Panchayats each in the UTs of Dadra and Nagar Haveli & Daman and Diu and Andaman & Nicobar Islands has also been approved for operationalization of Nari Adalat.

Till June 2026, out of the 2267 Nari Adalat meetings conducted, a total of 878 disputes and matters has been addressed out of which 703 disputes and matters have been resolved. The detailed information regarding the functioning of Nari Adalat in the UT of Jammu and Kashmir is at **Annexure**.

Further, Mission Shakti including working women hostel and Palna Schemes is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme and implementation responsibility of this scheme lies with the State Governments and UT Administrations. Funds are being released on the basis of guidelines of Department of Expenditure, prescribed for Single Nodal agency (SNA) or SNA SPARSH of the Public Financial Management System (PFMS). Once in a year, the Programme Approval Board (PAB) monitors with States and UTs the progress of activities under the scheme and reviews status of achievement of objectives, effective delivery of services to women and children. The States/UTs assess their requirement as per local needs and proposals are approved every year by the Programme Approval Board (PAB) after discussion with States/UTs.

The details of funds released/ expenditure in the UT of Jammu and Kashmir under 'Mission Shakti' since inception of the scheme are as under:
