PROMOTION OF DIGITAL LITERACY AMONG ANGANWADI WORKERS AND HELPERS IN ODISHA

2869. SMT. SULATA DEO:

Will the Minister of **WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry has undertaken any initiative to promote digital literacy among Anganwadi Workers and Helpers in Odisha; and
- (b) if so, the details of training programmes conducted?

(a) and (b): Poshan Tracker portal is Information and Communication Technology (ICT) based e-Governance tool of the Mission Saksham Anganwadi and Poshan 2.0. Poshan Tracker mobile Application enables Anganwadi Workers (AWWs) to digitally manage beneficiary records, monitor nutrition and Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) services, record child growth and use real-time data for service delivery.

The Digital Indian Corporation (DIC), Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, conducts training sessions of Anganwadi Workers (AWWs) on various Poshan Tracker modules through District and Block level Co-ordinators of Mission. In addition, the DIC team also conducts regular training sessions through Video Conference mode from Monday to Friday, between 03:00 PM and 04:00 PM, to facilitate capacity building and address operational queries related to Poshan Tracker Portal and App.

As per information provided by DIC, all 73,543 AWWs of Odisha have received training on Poshan Tracker modules.

In addition, Government of Odisha conducts 32-days Job Course Training for AWWs under the State Sector Scheme titled “State Support to ICDS Training”, including a 6-hour digital literacy session covering AWESOME, e-Manadeya, Tathya, Engagement Portal and Artificial Intelligence usage in day-to-day management.
