BENEFICIARIES UNDER AB-PMJAY IN HARYANA

286. # SHRI SANJAY BHATIA:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of eligible families and beneficiaries in Haryana received benefits under the Ayushman Bharat–Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) so far and the details thereof, district-wise;
- (b) whether Government has any proposal to provide Ayushman cards to all eligible families in Haryana and to increase the number of Ayushman Arogya Mandirs and empanelled hospitals, if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether any specific action plan has been prepared in Haryana for the widespread use of ABHA IDs and the complete integration of Government and private hospitals under the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission, if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER

(a): A total of 17.24 lakh families are eligible for benefits under Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) in the state of Haryana. The district-wise details of eligible families in the state of Haryana under AB-PMJAY are at **Annexure**.

(b): National Health Authority (NHA) and State Health Agencies have undertaken various measures to improve Ayushman card saturation, including the "Aapke Dwar Ayushman" campaign, door-to-door mobilisation by frontline workers, and support through Common Service Centres.

Under AB-PMJAY, hospital empanelment is a continuous process and is undertaken by the implementing State/UT based on the requirements and availability of healthcare providers meeting the criteria within a given State/UT as per empanelment guidelines of NHA. As on 30.06.2026, a total of 1,309 hospitals are empanelled under AB-PMJAY in the state of Haryana, comprising 719 private and 590 public hospitals.

Through 1.86 lakh Ayushman Arogya Mandirs (AAMs) in the country, including 3272 AAMs in Haryana, comprehensive primary healthcare is provided by strengthening Sub Health Centres (SHCs) and Primary Health Centres (PHCs).

(c): As on 16.07.2026, a total of 1.88 crore Ayushman Bharat Health Accounts (ABHA) have been created and 1.10 crore health records have been linked with ABHA in the state of Haryana under Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM). The e-Upchaar Hospital Management Information System (HMIS) has been implemented in 56 major public healthcare facilities and ABDM-enabled NextGen eHospital HMIS, in 571 smaller public health facilities. Besides, state has also conducted several activities like, organization of workshops and stakeholder consultations to promote the adoption of ABDM-enabled HMIS among private healthcare providers.
