- (a) whether the Shri Krishna Janmabhoomi complex in Mathura is one of India's most sacred and historical heritage sites;
- (b) whether the conservation of this complex is being carried out by the Archaeological Survey of India;
- (c) whether a scientific survey of Shri Krishna Janmabhoomi complex is being conducted by the court order; and
- (d) whether Government has any plan for the development of Shri Krishna Janmabhoomi complex, similar to the development of the Ram Janmabhoomi complex in Ayodhya?

ANSWER

- (a) The Shri Krishna Janmabhoomi Complex is most famous and sacred place in district Mathura.
- (b) It is not an ASI protected monument. No conservation work of the complex was done by the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI).
- (c) No scientific survey of the Shri Krishna Janmabhoomi Complex is being conducted by the ASI.
- (d) As on date, ASI has no such plans.
