**SOLAR ENERGY CAPACITY IN MADHYA PRADESH**

306. SMT. MAYA NAROLIYA

Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the mechanism adopted to monitor and verify the achievement of renewable energy targets by the States under PM Surya Ghar Yojana;
- (b) the details of the central assistance approved and released for increasing solar capacity in Madhya Pradesh;
- (c) the present status of the Rewa Ultra Mega Solar Park, Phase-III and the timeline for its commissioning; and
- (d) whether Government has assessed the potential impact of such solar capacity addition on the renewable energy share in Madhya Pradesh and if so, the district-wise details thereof?

**ANSWER**

**THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR NEW & RENEWABLE ENERGY AND POWER**

(a): The PMSG: MBY is a demand driven scheme wherein all residential consumers in the country, having a grid-connected electricity connection of the local DISCOM can avail the benefits of the scheme, for installation of RTS systems, by applying on the National Portal of the scheme. ([www.pmsuryaghar.gov.in](http://www.pmsuryaghar.gov.in)). The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE) has not allotted state-wise targets under the scheme. However, the progress of the scheme is being monitored at different levels including through review meetings with various stakeholders.

(b): During 2025-26 a total of Rs. 774.44 Cr released as central financial assistance to the state of Madhya Pradesh under various MNRE schemes for increasing solar capacity in the state. Scheme - wise details are given below: -

(c): The Government of Madhya Pradesh has informed that Rewa Ultra Mega Solar Limited has developed following solar parks in the state:

- 1) Rewa Solar Park (750 MW) - Commissioned in January 2020
- 2) Agar, Shajapur and Neemuch Solar Park (1330 MW)-Commissioned in April 2024, June 2025 and November 2024 respectively.
- 3) Omkareshwar Floating Solar Park (278MW) Commissioned in October 2024

(d) The total installed capacity of renewable power in the state of Madhya Pradesh is 9727 MW out of which solar power capacity is 6027 MW. The district-wise solar power capacity is given at **Annexure.**
