CBSE +2 Board Exams, 2026

336 Shri Anil Kumar Yadav Mandadi:

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) whether CBSE assured the students who appeared in +2 Board Exams– 2026 that if there is increase in marks of students after the re-evaluation of answer sheets refund of fee will be done;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) details of the amount that CBSE received from students after publication of +2 Board Exam results in May, 2026 for issuing scanned copies, verification and re-evaluating per question; and
- (d) the details of the amount refunded by CBSE to students after completing the entire re-evaluation process?

(a) to (d): The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) conducted the Class XII Board Examinations from 17th February 2026 to 9th April 2026. The Results of the same were declared on 13th May, 2026.

To ensure that no student wishing to avail of post-result facilities w.r.t the CBSE Class XII result was left behind, CBSE, vide Notice No. CBSE/COORD/PRDF/Class XII/2026 dated 17.05.2026, substantially reduced the fees for post result facilities, such as obtaining scanned copies of evaluated answer books, verification of issues observed and re-evaluation.

Further, in the interest of students, it was decided to refund the re-evaluation fee to candidates whose marks increased as a result of re-evaluation.

Out of the 17.69 lakh candidates who appeared in the Class XII Board Examination, 4.04 lakh candidates sought scanned copies of their evaluated answer books, while over 1.68 lakh candidates applied for verification of issues and/or re-evaluation.

As part of the reduced fee structure for post-result services, CBSE received Rs. 100 for each scanned copy of an evaluated answer book, Rs. 100 for verification of issues observed in an answer book, and Rs. 25 per question for re-evaluation. The re-evaluation fee is refunded in full to candidates where marks increased following re-evaluation process.
