Educational institutions in Odisha
338 Shri Dilip Kumar Ray:

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) how many Central Universities, Kendriya Vidyalayas, IITs, IIMs and Research Institutes and other Academies under Education departments of Union Government are functioning in the State of Odisha and district-wise list of such institutions;
- (b) what are the sanctioned strength of teaching, non-teaching staffs and research scholars of these institutions;
- (c) the number of regular vacancies in different departments, institution-wise in the State of Odisha; and
- (d) the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a): As per Unified District Information System for Education Plus (UDISE+) 2025-26, total number of Kendriya Vidyalayas in Odisha are 76. District-wise number of Kendriya Vidyalayas in the state of Odisha is given in annexure-I.

As per the All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) 2023-24, there are 5 Central Higher Educational Institutions (CHEIs) under Department of Higher Education in the State of Odisha. These institutions are as under: -

- i. Central University, Koraput
- ii. National Institute of Technology (NIT), Sundargarh
- iii. Indian Institute of Science Education & Research (IISER), Ganjam
- iv. Indian Institute of Management (IIM), Sambalpur
- v. Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Khordha

(b) to (d): Education being a subject in the concurrent list of the Constitution, creating and filling of vacancies in Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) and Schools in the country is the responsibility of both the Centre and States/UTs governments.

As per UDISE+ 2025-26, total number of teachers are 2,245 in Kendriya Vidyalayas in the State of Odisha. As per AISHE, 2023-24 there are 753 teachers, 686 non-teaching staff and 1,758 Ph.D. students in the HEIs under Department of Higher Education in the State of Odisha.
