- (a) whether the Land Port Management System (VINIMAY) has been operationalised at Integrated Check Posts (ICPs) across the country;**
- (b) the current status of integration of the system with stakeholder agencies;**
- (c) whether the Ministry has undertaken any assessment of the impact of the system on border management and trade facilitation, if so, the findings thereof;**
- (d) whether any roadmap has been prepared for expansion of the system to additional land ports; and**
- (e) if so, the details thereof?**

(SHRI NITYANAND RAI)**

(a): The Land Port Management System (VINIMAY) has been operationalized at 10 Integrated Check Posts (ICPs) namely at Agartala, Srimantapur, Darranga, Rupaidiha, Raxaul, Petrapole, Jogbani, Dawki, Sutarkandi and Attari.

(b): The Land Port Management System (LPMS) is integrated with the Unified Logistics Platform (ULIP), ICEGATE, the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH), and the Goods and Services Tax (GST) system.

(d) and (e): Land Ports Management System has been developed as a digital platform for management of operations at all existing and future ICPs.
