QUESTION

Implementation of PM-DEVINE

527 Smt. Rekha Sharma:

Will the Minister of **Development of North Eastern Region** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has formulated a comprehensive roadmap for implementation of projects sanctioned under the Prime Minister's Development Initiative for North East Region (PM-DevINE);
- (b) the present status of implementation, project-wise;
- (c) whether certain projects are facing delays or cost overruns, and
- (d) the corrective measures taken to ensure timely completion?

ANSWER

(a) The Prime Minister's Development Initiative for North East Region (PM-DevINE) is a Central Sector Scheme approved by the Union Cabinet with a total outlay of Rs.6,600 crore. The Scheme aims to support infrastructure, social development and livelihood projects in the North Eastern Region.

Ministry of DoNER has put in place a comprehensive framework for implementation of the scheme and monitoring of the sanctioned project. The framework, inter alia, includes appraisal of Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) by the State Level Empowered Committee (SLEC), approval by the Empowered Inter-Ministerial Committee (EIMC), milestone-based release of funds, regular review meetings with the State Governments and implementing agencies, monitoring through a dashboard and geo-tagged & time-stamped photographs, field inspections and site visits by officers of the Ministry/North Eastern Council(NEC)/Field Technical Support Units (FTSU) /Project Quality Monitors (PQM)/ Third Party Technical Inspection (TPTI) agencies, etc.

(b) Since inception of the Scheme in October 2022, a total of 53 projects worth Rs. 6,501.79 crore have been sanctioned under PM-DevINE upto 30.06.2026. Project-wise status is at **Annexure.**

(c) The scheduled dates of completion of a few projects have been revised primarily on account of the time taken in the award of works, site-specific issues, etc. The expenditure for all projects remains within the approved cost as per the Administrative and Financial Sanction (AFS).

(d) The Ministry conducts reviews of PM-DevINE projects through regular meetings with the State Governments and implementing agencies, monitoring through a dashboard and geo-tagged & time-stamped photographs, field inspections and site visits by officers of the Ministry/NEC.

Through these reviews, bottlenecks, if any, are identified and the State Govts./ Implementing Agencies are advised on measures to strengthen project monitoring, expedite execution, ensure timely utilisation of funds and adhere to the implementation schedule.
