INTEGRATION OF E-SHRAM PORTAL WITH NCS

568. DR. VIKRAMJIT SINGH SAHNEY:

Will the Minister of Labour and Employment be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has reviewed the integration of e-Shram portal with the National Career Service (NCS) portal to enhance employment opportunities for unorganised workers;**
- (b) the State-wise number of workers registered on the e-Shram portal and category-wise number in Punjab, along with those linked to social security schemes;**
- (c) the year-wise number of jobseekers from Punjab who secured employment through the NCS Portal during the last three years and whether all employment exchanges in the State have been integrated with the NCS portal; and**
- (d) the steps taken to strengthen convergence between e-Shram, NCS and social security schemes?**

ANSWER

**MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT

(a) to (d): The Ministry of Labour and Employment launched eShram portal (eshram.gov.in) on 26th August, 2021 for creation of a comprehensive National Database of Unorganised Workers (NDUW) including platform workers, migrant workers etc. The eShram portal registers the unorganised workers including gig and platform workers and provides them a Universal Account Number (UAN) on a self-declaration basis.

Over 31.79 crore unorganised workers have already been registered on eShram portal.

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State-wise details of unorganised workers registered on eShram Portal is at annexure-I.

Category-wise details of unorganised workers from the state of Punjab registered on eShram portal and scheme-wise enrolled under various social security schemes is at annexure II & III.

The eShram portal has been integrated with the National Career Service (NCS) portal. This integration enables eShram registrants to access the full range of services available on the NCS portal, such as job search and related facilities.

The NCS portal brings together Jobseekers and employers on one platform to facilitate job opportunities and career related services to the Jobseekers of the country. The NCS portal is integrated with State employment portal of Punjab. Further, notifying final hiring figures is not a mandatory requirement on NCS portal. However, the job hiring data is available only to the extent as voluntarily reported by the employers.

In keeping with the vision of the Budget Announcement 2024-25 on developing eShram as a One-Stop-Solution for unorganized workers to have access to various social security schemes, Ministry of Labour and Employment launched the eShram- “One-Stop-Solution” on 21st October 2024. eShram- “One-Stop-Solution” entails integration of different social security/ welfare schemes at single portal i.e. eShram. This enables unorganised workers registered on eShram to access social security schemes and see benefits availed by them so far, through eShram.

So far, fifteen (15) schemes of different Central Ministries/ Departments have already been integrated/ mapped with the eShram to extend benefits and access to social security, insurance or skill development programmes to eShram cardholders including Pradhan Mantri Street Vendors Atmanirbhar Nidhi (PMSVANidhi), Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY), Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY), Viksit Bharat-Guarantee for Rozgar and Aajeevika Mission (Gramin) (VB-G RAM G), Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Gramin (PMAY-G), Ayushman Bharat – Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY), Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban (PMAY-U), Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY), Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN), One Nation One Ration Card (ONORC) and Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY), etc.

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Apart from the above, eShram has linkages with National Career Service (NCS) for Job Opportunities, Skill India Digital Hub (SIDH) for Skill Development, Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maan-dhan (PM-SYM) for Pension and convergence portal of MoHUA.
