PRIME MINISTER INTERNSHIP SCHEME

636. SHRI RYAGA KRISHNAIAH:
DR. ANIL SUKHDEORAO BONDE:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) the role of MY Bharat platform in mobilising and facilitating youth participation in the Prime Minister Internship Scheme (PMIS), in collaboration with the Ministry of Corporate Affairs;
- (b) the number of youth who have registered for PMIS opportunities through MY Bharat platform, State/UT-wise;
- (c) how many PMIS outreach camps and on-ground facilitation drives have been organized by MY Bharat across the country and what has been the participation in these camps; and
- (d) how this collaboration advances the vision of a skilled and employable Bharat and the larger goal of Viksit Bharat @2047?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS & SPORTS
(DR. MANSUKH MANDAVIYA)

- (a) Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) has collaborated with MY Bharat and invited applications for Prime Minister Internship Scheme (PMIS) on MY Bharat platform by leveraging its nationwide digital platform and extensive field network for awareness generation, youth mobilization and facilitation. A dedicated PMIS Volunteer Opportunity (VO) has been published on the MY Bharat Portal, which is accessible to eligible youth across the country. The Volunteer Opportunity provides information about the Scheme and enables interested youth to seamlessly access the PMIS Portal for registration and application.
- (b) As on 16.07.2026 a total of 98,632 youth have been redirected through the PMIS Volunteer Opportunity published on the MY Bharat Portal to PMIS Portal for registration of application. The State/UT-wise details are at Annexure-I.

(c) As on 16.07.2026, in partnership with MY Bharat, the Prime Minister Internship Scheme (PMIS) has organized three outreach and internship camps to connect youth with internship opportunities offered by partner companies and organizations. These camps enabled direct engagement between candidates and companies, helping the youth learn about available roles, understand industry expectations, and complete application formalities. The details of the participation in the above camps is as follows:-

(d) The collaboration between MY Bharat and the Ministry of Corporate Affairs advances the vision of a Skilled and Employable Bharat by providing a structured pathway for youth to access industry internship opportunities through a nationwide digital platform supported by outreach and mobilisation efforts. It facilitates greater awareness, expands access to internship opportunities and strengthens linkages between youth, industry and Government initiatives. These efforts contribute to enhancing youth employability and support the larger vision of Viksit Bharat @2047 by enabling India's youth to become skilled, future-ready and active contributors to the nation's socio-economic development.
