ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR AMRUT 2.0 IN TAMIL NADU

65. SHRI R. GIRIRAJAN:

Will the Minister of *Housing and Urban Affairs* be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) in the State of Tamil Nadu selected under AMRUT 2.0 Mission, the financial allocation for each, and physical progress made so far;
- (b) whether Government has provided any special financial assistance, performance based grants, supplementary allocations to specific cities or towns in the State of Tamil Nadu during the last four years, if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether it is a fact that there are reported delays in release of the Central funds or reductions in allocations, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) 2.0 covers all Urban Local Bodies (ULBs)/ Cities of the country including all the ULBs in the State of Tamil Nadu. Under AMRUT 2.0, States/UTs are empowered to select, appraise, prioritise and implement the projects within the broad framework of Mission guidelines. The State of Tamil Nadu has taken up 1,263 projects worth ₹14,766.67 crore in 604 ULBs/ cities as per Mission guidelines under AMRUT 2.0 which includes 206 water supply projects worth ₹8,049.47 crore, 29 Sewerage & Septage Management projects worth ₹6,378.40 crore, 467 water body rejuvenation projects worth ₹225.83 crore and 561 green spaces and park projects worth ₹112.97 crore. Central assistance under AMRUT 2.0 is released to the States/UTs and not ULB-wise. The total central allocation (CA) for the State of Tamil Nadu for projects under this Mission is ₹4,942 crore. Total Central assistance of ₹2,614.18 crore (as on 09.07.2026) has been released/ sanctioned to the State for the projects.

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Besides funds for the projects, one time incentive of ₹40 Crore has been released as outcome based funding to Chennai city for achieving 85% saturation level for water supply coverage and 60% saturation level for Sewerage sector. ₹107.93 Crore has been released as incentive under Jal Hi Amrit initiative towards Sewage Treatment Plant performances. Further ₹91.61 Crore has been released as incentive towards issuance of municipal bonds for Chennai, Coimbatore, Tiruchirapalli and Tirupur corporations.

The funds are now released to the States through Mother Sanctions which are utilised by the State on real time basis. There has been no reduction in the approved project allocations for Tamil Nadu.
