COFFEE PRODUCTION AND SUPPORT FOR EXPORTS

693 SMT. SUMITRA BALMIK

Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:-

- (a) the production of coffee in the country, total domestic consumption and export (beans, ground, instant coffee) during the last three years, State-wise;
- (b) the steps being taken to promote coffee processing and value addition in the country, including the availability and adoption of freeze-drying technology for instant coffee;
- (c) whether Government proposes to further encourage the setting up of modern processing and freeze-drying facilities, so that a larger share of coffee is exported as high-value processed products rather than green beans; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, including any support envisaged for domestic manufacturers and grower cooperatives?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY

(a) The details regarding state-wise production of coffee during last three years are attached as Annexure I. The details of state-wise exports of coffee during last three years are attached as Annexure-II. Coffee is an export oriented commodity in India, wherein usually more than 70% of country's production is being exported while balance is consumed in the domestic market. Though Coffee Board does not maintain the domestic coffee consumption data separately, Coffee Board had assessed through a study done in 2023-24 that the domestic consumption was around 91,000 metric tonnes, out of total coffee production of 360,500 metric tonnes in 2023-24.

(b) to (d) Through its scheme 'Integrated Coffee Development Project (ICDP)', Coffee Board provides support to the coffee curing units for upgrading the machinery through introduction of improved technologies in coffee processing at the curing stage. Coffee Board also provides support to Roast & Ground (R&G) units for establishment of coffee roasting, grinding & packaging machinery. Coffee Board helps to promote value added coffees including freeze-dried instant coffees sold in retail packs (upto 1000 Gms) which have 'Coffees of India' logo in retail packs and also depict the words indicating 'Made in India'. Further, assistance is provided to growers for quality upgradation infrastructure including drying yards, godowns and pulper units to facilitate farm-level processing. The export of value added coffee has increased from 468 million USD to 686 million USD during the period 2023-24 to 2025-26, showing a growth of 46.58 %.
