NUMBER OF AIRPORTS OPERATIONAL UNDER UDAN SCHEME

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) the number of airports developed under UDAN scheme till date and number of airports that are currently operational, including cost of development of each airport separately;
- (b) the number of commercial flights undertaken from each airport since 2021 uptil 31st March, 2026; and
- (c) the number of Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS) aerodromes that have achieved financial self-sustainability after the three-year Operation and Maintenance (O&M) support window?

ANSWER

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (Shri Murlidhar Mohol)

(a): Under the UDAN Scheme, 95 airports (including 17 heliports and 02 water aerodromes) have been operationalised by the Selected Airline Operators (SAOs) across the country.

The airport-wise details of operationalised airports along with the expenditure incurred for their development are enclosed at Annexure.

(b): As on 10.07.2026, 170 routes operationalised under the UDAN Scheme are now commercially operating from various airports across the country.

(c): There is no provision for Operation and Maintenance (O&M) support under the UDAN scheme launched in 2016. Further, the modified UDAN Scheme launched on 04th July, 2026 has a provision for O&M support to aerodromes for three years.
