Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of rural households provided with Functional Household Tap Connections (FHTCs) so far in each district of the State of Uttar Pradesh under the Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM);
- (b) the amount of funds sanctioned, released and spent by the Central Government so far under the Jal Jeevan Mission in each district of the State; and
- (c) the number of drinking water projects completed, under construction and proposed so far under the scheme in each district of the State?

(a) to (c) The number of rural households provided with Functional Household Tap Connections (FHTCs) so far in each district of the State of Uttar Pradesh under the Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) is attached as **Annexure I**, which is available on JJM Dashboard. For implementation of Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM), the National Jal Jeevan Mission (NJJM) releases Central funds to the States/UTs. The implementation of the schemes and utilisation of funds thereafter are undertaken by the respective State/UT Governments. The district – wise allocation of central funds is not maintained by the Department of Drinking Water & Sanitation. The State/UT-wise details of Central allocation for FY 2019 – 20 to FY 2025-26, under JJM are available on the JJM-IMIS portal. The relevant link is provided below: -

In FY 2026-27, the Government of India has allocated Rs. 13,425.64 crore and released Rs. 869.67 crore to the state of Uttar Pradesh.

Numerous projects inter alia including projects aiming at strengthening water storage, distribution systems, or purification facilities are implemented concurrently at various levels across the States for achieving the envisaged objectives. Water being a state subject, project-wise details of individual projects/ schemes for rural water supply projects are not maintained at the Government of India level.
