FLOOD MANAGEMENT PROJECTS IN ODISHA

893 Shri MANAS RANJAN MANGARAJ:

Will the Minister of **Jal Shakti** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of flood management projects sanctioned for the State of Odisha till date;
- (b) the funds released and utilized for such projects;
- (c) the present status of the ongoing projects; and
- (d) whether any new proposals from Odisha are under consideration?

(a) & (b) Flood management and anti-erosion schemes are formulated and implemented by the concerned State Governments as per their priorities. The Union Government supplements the efforts of the States by providing technical guidance as well as promotional financial assistance for the management of floods in critical areas.

The Union Government is implementing a centrally sponsored scheme, namely, the Flood Management and Border Areas Programme (FMBAP) to provide central assistance to States for works related to flood control, anti-erosion, drainage development, anti-sea erosion, etc.

Total 68 number of Flood Management Projects have been sanctioned for the State of Odisha till date and Rs 119.42 Crore has been released as Central Assistance under FMBAP.

(c) No project is currently ongoing in the State of Odisha under the FMBAP.

(d) No new proposal from the State of Odisha is presently under consideration under FMBAP.
