Will the Minister of **POWER** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is considering the launch of a new generation of the National Mission for Enhanced Energy Efficiency (NMEEE 2.0);
- (b) if so, the proposed timeline and the manner in which NMEEE 2.0 will be aligned with the Indian carbon market and other emerging market based mechanisms to scale up investments in energy efficient technologies; and
- (c) whether NMEEE 2.0 will include a dedicated window for MSMEs and small enterprises, particularly those operating in energy intensive sectors, if so, the details thereof?

(a) : The National Mission for Enhanced Energy Efficiency (NMEEE) is one of the missions under the National Action Plan on Climate Change (NAPCC). It seeks to strengthen the market for energy efficiency through innovative policy and market-based mechanisms, including the Perform, Achieve and Trade (PAT) programme. At present, no proposal for a new generation of the National Mission for Enhanced Energy Efficiency (NMEEE 2.0) is under consideration in the Ministry of Power.

(b) & (c) : The seven energy-intensive sectors such as Aluminium, Cement, Chlor-Alkali, Pulp & Paper Petroleum Refinery, Petrochemicals and Textile covered under the PAT programme have been transitioned to the Indian Carbon Market (ICM) framework.

Further, for the energy-intensive Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs), Assistance for Deploying Energy Efficient Technologies in Industries and Establishments (ADEETIE) scheme has been launched in July 2025. The scheme handholds MSMEs operational in 60 clusters and 14 energy intensive sectors. It aims to facilitate Investment Grade Energy Audits (IGEA) to identify feasible technology interventions and provide financial support for implementation through interest subvention @ 5% for Small and Micro enterprises and 3% for Medium enterprises.
