INDEX OF SERVICES PRODUCTION AND GST DATA APPLICATIONS IN
BIHAR

958. SHRI SHAMBHU SHARAN PATEL:

Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government has successfully launched the trial monthly 'Index of Services Production' (ISP) using high-frequency external supply data from the GST network;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) the specific data filtration mechanisms deployed to stabilize the trial ISP indices during their initial testing phases; and

(d) the manner in which Government is planning to capture the variations in the non-digital informal services sector while using the 'Annual Survey of Incorporated Service Sector Enterprises'?

ANSWER

(a) and (b): Yes Sir. The Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation (MoSPI) has released the trial Index of Services Production (ISP) on 14.07.2026. The Index is compiled in respect of 19 sub-sectors using data of outward supplies from GST and other administrative data provided by source agencies on a monthly basis.

(c) The trial ISPs are released with an intent to receive feedback on the methodological framework from stakeholders, academicians and researchers. The techniques / mechanisms deployed to test stability of trial ISPs include use of appropriate deflators and validation of trends of trial ISPs with other secondary data sources.

(d) The ISP covers the formal sector of the economy. The Annual Survey of Incorporated Service Sector Enterprises (ASISSE) covers the Incorporated Services Sector. For measuring the unincorporated sector of the economy, the Ministry undertakes Annual Survey of Unincorporated Sector Enterprises (ASUSE) and publishes quarterly and annual results.
