**FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AND CLUSTER DEVELOPMENT UNDER THE
SCHEME FOR SETTING UP OF PLASTIC PARKS**

978 SHRI AMAR PAL MAURYA:

Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

- a. the state-wise number of plastic parks that have been approved so far under the Scheme for Setting up of Plastic Parks, the number of completed and operational plastic parks out of them, and the current status of approved and operational plastic parks in Uttar Pradesh;
- b. the state-wise details of the central financial assistance approved, the amount released, and the actual amount utilized for the development of common infrastructure facilities under the scheme, and the details of the amount approved and spent for Uttar Pradesh; and
- c. the performance of the plastic parks in Uttar Pradesh?

ANSWER

(a) & (c): Under the Scheme for Setting up of Plastic Parks, the Department of Chemicals and Petrochemicals has approved setting up of ten Plastic Parks in the States of Assam, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh (two Plastic Parks), Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand.

Of these, four Plastic Parks, namely Tamot (Madhya Pradesh), Jagatsinghpur (Odisha), Bilaua (Madhya Pradesh) and Raipur (Chhattisgarh) have completed 100% of the physical infrastructure (civil work). Industrial units have started operations in Tamot (Madhya

Pradesh), Jagatsinghpur (Odisha), Bilaua (Madhya Pradesh), Tinsukia (Assam) and Gorakhpur (Uttar Pradesh).

The Plastic Park at Gorakhpur in the State of Uttar Pradesh was approved in July 2022. Common infrastructure development is in progress and the overall physical progress of infrastructure development (civil works) is 83%. Out of 92 industrial plots, 66 have been allotted, with 4 units currently operational. The park has generated employment for 320 persons.

(b): State-wise details of the Central financial assistance approved, amount released / and the amount utilized for development of common infrastructure facilities under the Scheme, including Uttar Pradesh, are as under:
