Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

- a. the state-wise number of functional Plastic Parks approved and operationalised under the cluster development scheme;
- b. the precise ratio of central financial assistance sanctioned versus actual funds utilised for setting up common infrastructure facilities; and
- c. whether real-time dashboard data registers an increase in value-added plastic exports from these specialised clusters?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS
(SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)

(a): Under the Scheme for Setting up of Plastic Parks, the Department of Chemicals and Petrochemicals has approved ten Plastic Parks in the States of Assam, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh (two Plastic Parks), Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand.

Of these, four Plastic Parks, namely Tamot (Madhya Pradesh), Jagatsinghpur (Odisha), Bilaua (Madhya Pradesh) and Raipur (Chhattisgarh) have completed 100% of the physical infrastructure (civil work). Industrial units have started operations in five Plastic Parks, i.e. Tamot (Madhya Pradesh), Jagatsinghpur (Odisha), Bilaua (Madhya Pradesh), Tinsukia (Assam) and Gorakhpur (Uttar Pradesh).

(b): Under the Scheme, the Government of India provides grant-in-aid of up to 50% of the project cost, subject to a ceiling of Rs. 40.00 crore per project for development of common infrastructure facilities. State-wise details of the Central financial assistance approved, amount released/utilized for development of common infrastructure facilities under the Scheme are as under:
