Will the Minister of MINORITY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether scholarships are provided under merit-cum-means based scholarship scheme for minorities;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Rajasthan for the last three years and the current year; and
- (c) whether the Government has assessed the working/implementation of the scheme and if so, the outcome thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF MINORITY AFFAIRS (SHRI MUKHTAR ABBAS NAQVI)

(a) to (c): A Statement is laid on the Table of the House.

Statement referred to in reply to parts (a) to (c) of Lok Sabha Starred Question No. *107 for answer on 23.11.2016 raised by Shri Gajendra Singh Shekhawat regarding "Merit-cum-Means based Scholarship"

- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. For the educational empowerment of minority students all over the Country, including State of Rajasthan, the Ministry of Minority Affairs provides financial assistance through scholarship schemes under Merit-cummeans (MCM) based Scholarship Scheme for professional and technical courses. The number of scholarships awarded under Merit-cum-means based scholarship scheme, State-wise including State of Rajasthan, for the last three years and current year is Annexed.
- (c): Merit-cum-Means based Scholarship Scheme has been evaluated by the Ministry of Minority Affairs through Research & Development Initiative (RDI) in 2013. Major findings of the impact assessment of the scheme are as under:

"The Merit-cum-Means based Scholarship Scheme has been able to meet its objectives to a large extent. It has reached the most deprived in the minority communities; raised their demand for technical and professional education; somewhat reduced the financial burden of poor parents; enabled a large proportion of beneficiaries to stay through their technical/professional course; improved their performance levels; and more significantly raised their aspirations for further study. These perceived impacts of the Merit-cum means based Scholarship Scheme is statistically significant. The scheme has contributed significantly towards the developmental objective of empowering the minority communities through education".
