# STATEMENT REFERRED IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. \*109 FOR 23.11.2016 REGARDING SOFTWARE TECHNOLOGY PARKS OF INDIA.

. . . . . . . . . .

(a) to (d): A total of 56 Software Technology Parks of India (STPI) Centres have been setup across the country. State-wise list of STPI centres is at Annexure-I. During the last one year, two new STPI centres have been set-up in Gurgaon (Haryana) and Surat (Gujarat). The state-wise list of 23 STPI centres proposed to be set-up is at Annexure-II.

As per policy for setting up a new STPI Centre, State Government or centres of Excellence/Higher Educational Institution is required to provide minimum 2 acres of developed land or 50,000 sq. ft. built-up area free of cost on long term lease. In case, State Government/Centres of Excellence/Higher Educational Institution provides minimum 2 acres of land, STPI will construct minimum 20,000 sq. ft. built-up space. The cost for setting up of new STPI centre shall be borne by STPI only from its internal accruals. Hence, no funds are allocated by the Government for the same.

While the initiative for setting up a new STPI centre lies with the State Government, STPI jointly with the State Government concerned is required to conduct a feasibility study to evaluate the export potential and commercial viability of the proposed location.
