CLEANING OF GANGA RIVER BASIN

Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has identified the polluted stretch in rivers flowing in the Ganga basin;
- (b) if so, the details of such rivers along with the river-wise quantum of effluents being released into the basin;
- (c) whether such rivers need to be cleansed at the earliest; and
- (d) if so, the reaction of the Government thereto?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER FOR WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION
(SUSHRI UMA BHARTI)

(a) and (b): Yes, Madam. Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) has identified 57 polluted stretches on 47 Rivers in Ganga River Basin. Details are given at **Annexure-1**. As per the Ganga Basin Management Plan prepared by Consortium of IIT, about 12050 mld of sewage is generated from Class 1 and Class II towns in 11 Ganga Basin States. The total sewage generation from 15 cities along Yamuna River is estimated as 5021.4 mld.

(c) to (d): The Union Government has attached top most priority to address the challenges and issues relating to pollution and a comprehensive Ganga Conservation Mission – ‘Namami Gange’ is under implementation covering short term; medium term and long term activities.

Under short term action plan, certain interventions have been visualized under the heading of ‘Entry Level Activities which covers development of ghats, crematoria and river surface cleaning activities.

Under medium term action plan, existing Sewage Treatment Plants (STPs) and Effluent Treatment Plants (ETPs) will be upgraded and new STPs and ETPs will be established with an aim to stop untreated sewerage and industrial wastes falling in the river. Besides, rural sanitation has been taken up in the villages on the banks of River Ganga.

The long term action plan involves restoration of wholesomeness of River Ganga, maintaining the ecological and geological integrity of the river.
