be pleased to state:

- (a) whether e-platform of the National Agriculture Market (e-NAM) has seen lukewarm response and if so, the facts thereof along with the reasons therefor;
- (b) whether there is a proposal to allow inter-State trade to boost agricultural income and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether only 250 regulated wholesale markets spread across 12 States under the respective Agricultural Produce Marketing Committees (APMCs) have so far been integrated with the e-NAM platform and if so, the reasons therefor;
- (d) the details of the agricultural products presently under e-NAM and the total trade turnover achieved under e-NAM so far, State-wise; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Government to accelerate the process and achieve the target of integration of 400 APMCs in various States along with effective implementation of the e-NAM scheme in the country?

(a) to (e): A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF LOK SABHA  
STARRED QUESTION NO. 299 DUE FOR REPLY ON 6<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER, 2016.**

(a): The response of the States for integration of APMCs with States is quite encouraging. Against a target of integration of 200 mandis by 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2016; 238 mandis from 10 States have been integrated with e-NAM platform. Till 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2016, 23.86 lakh MT of agri-commodities worth Rs. 4558 Crore has been traded on e-NAM which indicates a good response from the users.

(b): Yes, Madam. The e-NAM aims at integrating the primary agricultural markets (APMCs) both within and across states. The progress will happen in a phased manner. The inter market online trade on the e-NAM platform requires some statutory changes to the APMC act. Department is working on this and a committee has been constituted under the chairman ship of Dr Ashok Gulati to examine the needed changes.

(c): So far 250 APMCs from 10 States have been integrated with e-NAM platform.

(d): Details of products presently traded on e-NAM and the total trade turnover so far achieved under e-NAM is provided in **Annexure-I**.

(e): Department has so far granted in principle approval for integration of 399 APMCs from 14 States, with e-NAM. It is targeted to achieve integration of a cumulative of 400 mandis by March, 2017. Department along with SFAC is closely monitoring the progress of implementation.
