- ii. 2007 Benchmarking and Data Book of Water Utilities in India

(b) & (c): To address the challenges related to water supply and
sanitation sectors in urban areas, Government of India has launched
Swachh Bharat Mission and the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and
Urban Transformation (AMRUT).

10% of the Mission outlay under AMRUT is earmarked for
incentivizing the reforms in urban governance including those in
water supply and sanitation sectors.
