- (a) the number of historical monuments and heritage sites maintained by the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether heritage sites in the country are being given to private companies for their renovation and maintenance and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) the other steps taken by the Government to promote private sector's involvement in heritage promotion along with the details thereof; and
- (d) whether ASI has undertaken responsibility of maintaining historical/heritage sites situated in foreign countries also and if so, the details thereof?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PART (a) TO (d) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.74 FOR 21.11.2016

- (a) The State-wise list of 3686 monuments/sites maintained by the Archaeological Survey of India in the country is at Annexure.
- (b) As on date, Archaeological Survey of India has undertaken conservation and development of Humayun's Tomb, Delhi in collaboration with Aga Khan Trust for Culture (AKTC) and conservation and development of Tomb of Mohammed Shah known as Mubarak Shah's Gumbad, Delhi in collaboration with Indian National Trust for Cultural Heritage (INTACH). Further MOU's have been signed with State Governments for maintenance and upgrading visitor facilities. However, in no case whole work is entrusted to any private company.
- (c) Archaeological Survey of India has issued an Expression of Interest on Public Private Partnership Module (PPP) for providing World class facilities at the important tourist visited monuments/sites. Under this Expression of Interest (EOI) 20 different services which includes webbased information and other innovative ideas which enhance the popularity of the monument and bring it at par have been offered.
- (d) On request from MEA the ASI has taken up conservation work of Ta Prohm Temple in Combodia, Vat Phom temple in Lao PDR and Anande Temple in Myanmar.
