(a) to (c) Prasar Bharati has informed that the foundation stone for proposed station at Ranti Mouza, Madhubani was laid by the then Hon'ble Minister of Information & Broadcasting (I&B) on 19.01.2004. The proposed site was a private land and demand note for purchasing the site was not received from the State Government during the 10th Plan period. Hence, the station could not come into existence during 10th Plan period. The same could not be included in 11th Plan period due to shortage of resources.
