Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received proposals for special package from various States in the country for development of the Scheduled Caste dominated areas;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Rajasthan;
- (c) whether the said proposals have been approved or are still pending; and
- (d) the time by which the pending proposals are likely to be approved, State-wise?

ANSWER

**MINISTER FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT

- (a): Yes, Sir. Proposals have been received from various States/UTs for allocation under the Special Central Assistance to Scheduled Caste Sub Plan Scheme.
- (b): Gross Budgetary Support (GBS) under the scheme is notionally allocated to States / UTs on the basis of stipulated criteria like SC population of the States / UTs, Net State Domestic Product (NSDP), allocation done under Scheduled Castes Sub Plan of the States / UTs and no. of SC families covered under Composite Economic Development Programmes. The State-wise details is given at **Annexure**.
- (c): Notional allocations have been approved for all the States/UTs including Rajasthan.
- (d): Does not arise
