- (b) the number of domestic pharmaceuticals taken over by the multinational companies during the above period;
- (c) the extent to which the prices of medicines have increased after taking over of domestic pharmaceutical companies and the justification for such price increase; and
- (d) whether the Government proposes to ban the partnership of multinational companies with domestic pharmaceutical companies so that domestic pharmaceutical industry could be saved and if so, the details thereof?
