(a) to (e): Track renewal is a continuous activity. Replacement of Railway tracks is sanctioned annually as and when a stretch of track becomes due for track renewal on age-cum-condition basis i.e. on the basis of traffic carried over the track and physical condition of track. As on 01.04.2016, 5900 km of track renewal is sanctioned, out of which 2668 km has been targeted for completion in 2016-17. The details of track renewal target and achievement, amount allocated and expenditure incurred for the current year are as under:
