STAMPEDE CASES

†1138. SHRI VENKATESH BABU T.G.: SHRI ALOK SANJAR:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether several incidents of stampede have been reported at various places of worship/pilgrimage centres;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the number of such cases reported, persons killed/injured and the action taken against the responsible persons, separately during each of the last three years and the current year, gender, location and State-wise;
- (c) whether any inquiry has been conducted in this regard and if so, the details and outcome thereof along with the followup action taken thereon, State-wise;
- (d) the financial assistance provided to the families of the victims of such stampede during the said period, State-wise;
- (e) whether any Standard Operating Procedure/guidelines on crowd management and evacuation procedures has been framed and if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) the steps taken by the Government to provide training to police personnel on crowd management and evacuation procedures along with the details of advisories issued to the States and Police departments to prevent such incidents in future?

(a) to (c): Based on the available information, the details of the incidents of stampede in different parts of the country are provided at Annexure.

As per the VII Schedule to the Constitution of India, Public order and police are state subjects. The State Governments concerned are primarily responsible for security and maintenance of law & order in religious places. They are required to conduct inquiry into the incidents of stampede and to take appropriate action against the persons responsible for such incidents.

- (d): The State Governments are also required to provide relief including financial assistance to the injured and families of the deceased in such incidents. In addition, Ex-gratia payment to the next of the kin of the deceased and those injured has been made from time to time from the Prime Minister's relief fund.
- (e) & (f): The Government of India issues advisories to State

 Governments/UT administrations from time to time with regard to

crowd management and to ensure security and safety of the people visiting such religious places. A detailed advisory was issued to all States/UTs on 01.10.2008 emphasizing the need to manage large gatherings and suggesting measures such as allowing manageable number of persons to visit the temples/shrines at a particular time; proper access control procedure/system at every entry/exit point; establishing sound alert system; regular training of staff in evaluation procedures' etc. Crowd control and management is part of basic police training for all ranks in the police force. The State Governments/UT Administrations are required to constantly upgrade training syllabus and methodology relating to crowd control and management.
