DEVELOPMENT OF RAILWAY STATIONS

†115. SHRI RATTAN LAL KATARIA:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Railway department had declared Yamuna Nagar Railway station as 'A' class railway station in the last year's budget;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) the details of facilities required to be provided therein after granting 'A' class status to any railway station;**
- (d) whether separate budgetary provisions have been made in this regard; and**
- (e) if so, the details thereof?**

ANSWER

(a) & (b): As per policy norms, based on the annual passenger earnings of 2011-12, Jagadhari Railway station at Yamuna Nagar has been classified as an "A" Category station and all essential passenger amenities have already been provided at the station. Improvement of passenger amenities at stations is a continuous and on-going process.

(c): Facilities like booking counter, drinking water, waiting hall, seating arrangement, platform shelter, urinals, latrines, high level platforms,

lighting, fans, Foot Over Bridge, time table display, Clock, Water cooler, Public Address system, Parking, electronic Train indicator board, Public Phone booth, signage are required to be provided at 'A' category stations.

(d) & (e): The expenditure on provision/improvement/augmentation of amenities at railway stations is generally funded under Plan Head – 'Passenger Amenities'. ₹ 75.06 crores have been allocated under this Plan Head during the current year to Northern Railway which covers Jagadhari railway station.
