ECONOMY HOTEL AT RAILWAY STATIONS

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has made any efforts to open economy hotels at the railway stations in the country including Madhya Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the details in this regard, State-wise; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

(a) to (c): Provision exists for Budget Hotels to come up as a part of Multi Functional Complex (MFC) subject to their commercial viability. 197 stations have been identified for development of Multi Functional Complexes (MFCs) over Indian Railways, out of which 58 stations have been found suitable for Budget Hotels. 10 stations have been identified for development of MFCs in Madhya Pradesh viz. Chhindwara, Gwalior, Indore, Jabalpur, Khajuraho, Neemuch, Rewa, Ratlam, Sanchi and Ujjain out of which Budget Hotels may be developed at 6 stations viz., Gwalior, Indore, Jabalpur, Ratlam, Sanchi and Ujjain depending upon their commercial viability.
