12. SHRI S. P. MUDDAHANUME GOWDA: SHRI C. S. PUTTA RAJU:

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether some top ranking Pakistani leaders in the recent past have threatened use of atom bomb against India;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the steps taken/being taken by the Union Government in this regard?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS [GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD)]

- (a) Yes.
- (b) Pakistan's Federal Minister of Defence Khwaja Muhammad Asif in a recent interview to a Pakistani television channel while responding to a question whether Pakistan would use nuclear weapons in case of a war, stated that "in defence of Pakistan, for the safety of the country, we may use nuclear weapons, if required". He has made similar statements in the past as well.
- (c) Government monitors all developments which have a bearing on national security and takes all necessary steps to safeguard the nation's security.
