Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the details of where skill development centres have been set up in the country under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY); and
- (b) the target fixed for training the number of youth in Chhattisgarh State in the last three years and the current year along with the number of people trained?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY)

- (a) Under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), total 13,233 training centres (12191 in short term training and 1042 under Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)) have been set up for imparting skill training during 2015-16. These training centres are spread across 23 States and 1 Union Territory in the country. Under PMKVY (2016-2020), the Government aims to skill one crore people over the four years (2016-2020). As on 13.11.2016, 118 centers have been allocated targets under short term training.
- (b) Under PMKVY (2015-16), in the state of Chhattisgarh, 36,488 candidates have been trained in fresh training and 814 in RPL category. The target of training 12,133 candidates each year has been set subsequently for four years (2016-20) under State Engagement Component of PMKVY. In addition, PMKVY training will also be delivered through National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) across the Country including Chhattisgarh.
