PRAVASI KAUSHAL VIKAS YOJANA FOR OVERSEAS

1240. SHRI K.C. VENUGOPAL:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has taken any steps to ensure skill development for the Indian work force going for overseas employment under Pravasi Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PKVY);
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the training partners of the PKVY at State and district levels in various States including Kerala;
- (d) whether Government has taken any measures to implement the scheme in States like Kerala where a large number of unskilled work force is migrating abroad;
- (e) if so, the details thereof;
- (f) whether Government has instituted any permanent institutional mechanism for the scheme;
- (g) if so, the details thereof; and
- (h) the actions taken under the scheme for skill development ventures for domestic workers going abroad?

(a) to (h) Yes Madam. Pravasi Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PKVY) is aimed at training and certification of Indian workforce keen on overseas employment in select sectors and job roles, in line with international standards, to facilitate overseas employment opportunities. The scheme will be implemented by National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) through its Training Partners. Potential emigrant workers may avail work related skill training under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) at the designated India International Skill Centres (IISCs), which would take place at transnational standards.

Ministry has set up 16 India International Skill Centers (IISCs) under pilot phase, which also covers the Skill training for domestic workers, across various States in India for implementation of Pravasi Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PKVY). The list of 16 IISCs in the various States including the State of Kerala is given at **Annexure**.
