- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the aims and objectives thereto;
- (c) whether the Government has celebrated Vigilance Awareness Week, 2016 recently; and
- (d) if so, the initiatives taken by the Government to make the Vigilance Awareness Week a successful event?

- (a): Yes, Madam. The Vigilance Awareness Week is observed every year.
- (b): The aim of observing vigilance awareness week is to promote integrity, transparency and accountability in public life. It also aims at attaining a corrupt free society wherein all the stakeholders including government, citizens and also the private sector participate in the fight against corruption. Further, people are sensitized about the adverse consequences of corruption and ways to eliminate it.
- (c): Yes, Madam. The Vigilance Awareness Week was celebrated this year from 31st October, 2016 to 4th November, 2016.
- (d): In addition to administering oath to Government & Public Sector employees, to create greater awareness and participation of the public, at large, two õIntegrity Pledgeö, as envisaged by the Central Vigilance Commission, were taken by individual citizens as well as by corporate entities, firms, etc., affirming their commitment to prevent and combat corruption. Further, programmes were arranged in some schools and colleges, trade bodies, offices, villages etc. to promote awareness in public on ills of corruption and need for integrity.
