(a) to (d) Government is committed to strengthen mobile network facility in the areas affected by Left Wing Extremism (LWE). 2199 mobile towers are being set up in Left Wing Extremism (LWE) affected States with a total estimated cost of Rs.3567.58 crore. The work is being executed by Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL). As on date, 2185 mobile towers are made operational under this Project. These locations are identified by Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA). Further, no significant complaint has been received for the mobile towers installed under this Project. State-wise breakup of LWE Mobile Towers is at Annexure.
