(a) and (b): NSSO has conducted an all-India household survey on Social Consumption on Education during its $71^{\text {st }}$ round (January 2014 - June 2014). The purpose of the survey was to collect information on participation of persons aged 05-29 years in pursuit of education, the extent of use of educational infrastructure \& facilities, incentives provided by the government $\&$ private areas and its impact on current attendance status of population in the educational institutions; private expenditure incurred by households on education, the extent of drop-outs \& discontinuation from education and its causes. Based on the results of this survey, estimates of state-wise percentage distribution of females by completed level of education are given in the Statement at the Annexure.
