- (c) the percentage of profit earned by the Railways by selling per litre of rail neer; and
- (d) the justification for huge margin of profit?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): Average cost of one litre bottle of "Rail Neer" is □ 9.22 and its
transfer price for supplies made in locations within 75 kms. of the
manufacturing plant is \hdots 10.00 $$ and $$ beyond that distance is \hdots 10.50.
The Indian Railway Catering & Tourism Corporation Limited (IRCTC)
sells one litre Rail Neer at \hdots 10.32 to the vendors. However, the
maximum retail price of one litre Rail Neer bottle is $\square15$ /- at Railways'
premises. Licensees are paid the handling charges, inclusive of
cooling expenses etc.
(c): The percentage of profit earned by the IRCTC by selling per litre of
Rail Neer is 11.93%.
(d): There is only a marginal profit of □ 1.10 per bottle on Rail Neer to
