FLIGHTS BETWEEN INDIA AND UAE

- (a) the number of flights operating between India and Dubai by different airlines at present;
- (b) whether UAE airlines are utilising its full capacity while Indian airlines are utilising only 80% of the permitted slots;
- (c) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether India has recently held talks with UAE for more slots to Indain airlines to use their full capacity; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and present position of the talks between the two countries and the time by which a final decision is likely to be taken by both the countries in this regard?

- (a) At present, the airlines of India and UAE(Dubai) are operating 559 flights per week on India-Dubai Route.
- (b) & (c) No madam. The airlines of India and UAE(Dubai) are utilizing their full capacity on India-Dubai Route.
- (d) & (e) No madam. However, the bilateral talks between the two countries are held from time to time, as and when both parties agree to discuss.
