**UPGRADATION OF STATE HIGHWAYS TO NATIONAL HIGHWAYS**

(a) to (c) The Ministry keeps on receiving proposals for declaration of various State roads from various States/Union Territories (UTs) as new National Highways (NHs). The Ministry considers declaration of State Roads as new NHs from time to time keeping in view the requirement of connectivity, inter-se priority and availability of funds. The details of State roads declared as new NHs in the country during last three years and the current year are annexed.
