(a)to(d):Details of existing draft and proposed draft in the entrance channels in the 12 Major Ports is placed at the enclosed <u>Annexure.</u> In view of draft limitations, Visakhapatnam Port can handle all types of vessels/ships requiring 18.1 metres draft. Chennai Port can handle tankers requiring 17 metres draft during high waters at Bharathi Dock-III. Kandla Port has the capability of handling ships requiring 17 metres draft at Tuna Tekra Terminal and at Vadinar.
