SURVEY ON INTER-LINKING OF RIVERS

Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the location-wise number of surveys conducted under the river linking projects in various States and Union Territories in the country;
- (b) the amount allocated/released/spent for the said surveys during the last three years, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether any survey has been conducted in Tamil Nadu; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the action taken thereon?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION (DR. SANJEEV KUMAR BALYAN)

(a) Under the National Perspective Plan for water resources development through inter basin transfer of water prepared by the then Ministry of Irrigation, now Ministry of Water Resources, RD & GR, NWDA has identified 30 links (16 under Peninsular Component & 14 under Himalayan Component) for preparation of Feasibility Reports (FRs). The pre-feasibility report of the all 30 links have been prepared and circulated to the concerned State Govts. by the NWDA. After survey and investigations, Feasibility Reports of 14 links under Peninsular Component and Feasibility Reports of 2 links and draft Feasibility Reports of 7 links (Indian portion) under Himalayan Component have been completed. Present status, States concerned and States benefiting from Inter Basin Water Transfer Links are given in Annex-I. After completion of FRs, preparation of the Detailed Project Report (DPR) is taken up based on consensus amongst the States concerned. Preparation of DPR of the ILR project also includes surveys and investigations in detail.

Four priority links for preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR) under Peninsular Rivers Component have been identified viz; Ken-Betwa Link, Phase –I & II, Damanganga-Pinjal Link, Par-Tapi-Narmada link and Mahanadi-Godavari link. Detailed Project Report (DPR) of

Ken – Betwa Link Project has already been prepared, appraised by CWC and accepted by Advisory Committee of this Ministry and its various statutory clearances are in the advance stages. The Detailed Project Report (DPR) of Damanganga-Pinjal link has also been prepared, appraised by CWC and accepted by Advisory Committee of this Ministry. Detailed Project Report (DPR) of Par-Tapi-Narmada link project has also been completed by NWDA and submitted to the concerned States of Gujarat and Maharashtra in August 2015.

b) The Grants-in-aid released to NWDA by MOWR/ Expenditure by NWDA in the last three years for surveys and investigations including salaries of NWDA staff are as follows:

(c) & (d) The surveys and investigations in Tamil Nadu for preparation of feasibility report of three links i.e. Pennar (Somasila) - Cauvery (Grand Anicut) link, Cauvery (Kattalai) - Vaigai - Gundar link and Pamba - Achankovil - Vaippar link under Peninsular Component of National Perspective Plan (NPP) have been carried out. The feasibility reports of these three links have been prepared and circulated to the concerned States.

Surveys and investigations of one intra-State link i.e. Ponnaiyar – Palar link of Tamilnadu has also been carried out for preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR).
