- (b) whether the Government proposes to re-start the closed mines;

## THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR POWER, COAL, NEW & RENEWABLE ENERGY AND MINES (SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL)

(a): As per information made available by Indian Bureau of Mines, a sub-ordinate office of the Ministry of Mines, all the chromite mines reporting production are located in the States of Karnataka, Maharashtra and Odisha, wherein 95% reserves/resources are available. None of these mines was closed during the last three years.
