National Sports University

1503. DR. THOKCHOM MEINYA:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) the present status of setting up of National Sports University in Manipur;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to commence the classes at Khuman Lampak Sports Complex as a temporary arrangement till the completion of work on new university;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the time by which the new university is likely to be set up and become functional?

ANSWER

(a) Pursuant to a decision to set up National Sports University in Manipur, 336.93 acres of land has been acquired at 44-Yaithibi Khunou, Thoubal District of Manipur by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports. However, a patch of 34 acres at the site, which is under litigation, is awaiting transfer. In addition, the site is a low-lying area, susceptible to flooding. A professional team has been constituted to furnish a final report about the site. For setting up the proposed University, Hindustan Steelworks Construction Limited (HSCL), a Central Public Sector Undertaking, has been appointed as the Project Management Consultant.

(b) & (c) No such decision has yet been taken.

(d) It is proposed to set up the University and make it functional in a span of five years.
