Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is planning to construct 118 km long and 60 meter wide 10-lane Bengaluru-Mysuru Expressway that promises to cut travel time between the two cities, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has completed the land acquisition process for the above project, if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to expedite the construction of Bengaluru Mysuru Expressway?

- (a) Yes madam. Feasibility report for six laning with 2-Lane service road on either side of Bengaluru to Mysuru section (Km 18.000 near Panchamukhi temple, Bengaluru to Km 135.300 near Columbia Asia hospital junction, Mysuru of NH-275) is under finalization.
- (b) Out of 448 ha land acquisition, notification for 388 ha under section 3(D) of NH Act is already published.
- (c) To expedite project related Pre-construction activities, NHA I has opened a new Project Implementation Unit at Ramanagaram.
