(a) to (c) The details and number of National Highways (NHs) to be converted in four lanes by the Government during 2016, State and NH-wise are annexed. Four laning of National Highways, depending upon the traffic, is done and land is acquired in states. The time of completion of these projects is generally kept two to three years.
